The Danish Embassy is looking for a Political Affairs Officer to help coordinate our climate cooperation

Interested in working with Danish-Brazilian bilateral relations with a focus on our cooperation within Climate and Global Climate Politics? The Danish Embassy in Brasilia is seeking to recruit an efficient and proactive Political Affairs Officer from August 1st 2024 or as soon as possible hereafter for a temporary position running until 31st of December 2025.

As a member of the political section of the embassy, you will help coordinate our collaboration with Brazil related to G20, COP30 and other high level events taking place over the next 18 months.

Main tasks and responsibilities as Political Affairs Officer

- Arrange, participate and report on meetings with relevant local and international stakeholders with a main focus on events related to climate
- Develop and implement projects related to climate change and sustainable development.
- Prepare visits by Danish delegations to Brazil and vice versa.
- Analyse and report on political, social and economic developments and mayor events related to climate in Brazil.

For an optimal handling of the entire portfolio of the Embassy, you are also expected to contribute to tasks and projects in other areas of the Embassy's work. This includes supporting the strategic sector co-operations between Danish and Brazilian authorities within sustainable energy, health, intellectual property and digital government, supporting the posted staff sent out in these areas.

Required qualifications

- Minimum bachelor degree in political sciences, international relations, economics, or related areas. A postgraduate degree is highly desirable.
- Familiarity to climate cooperation and global climate politics is a plus, but not a requirement
- Ability to identify, analyse and communicate political and economic developments in Brazil
- At least two years of relevant work experience
- Excellent spoken and written Portuguese and English.
- Danish and/or Spanish skills are a plus but not a requirement
- A pro-active, open-minded, creative approach to handling of tasks and solid networking skills
- Flexible and able to adapt to the changing needs of the Embassy
- Self-motivated team player, able to drive processes and initiatives.
